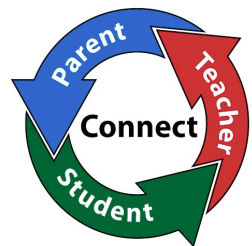
### After School/Breakfast Club Provision from September

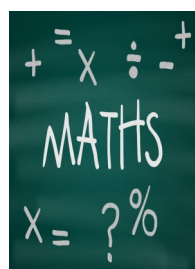

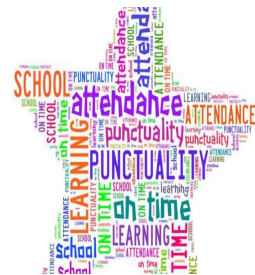

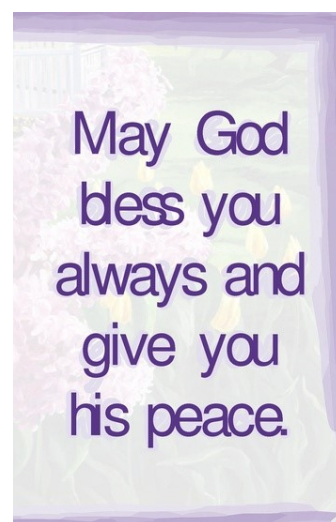
