Geography Field Trips

Next week, our Geography field trips to Hampstead Heath and Epping Forest will continue as part of their Geography learning this half term. These will be on the following days:

- Tuesday 19th September: Year 3 to Hampstead Heath;
- Wednesday 20th September: Year 5 to Hampstead Heath and Year 6 to Epping Forest;
- Thursday 21st September: Year 4 to Hampstead Heath.

Children will travel to and from Hampstead Heath/Epping Forest using public transport and will be provided with a packed lunch to take with them. Do ensure they are in on time on those days, have a bag to carry their packed lunch, a water bottle and a suitable jacket. They should all be back before the end of the school day for normal collection times. If you would like to join, please check with class teachers should they be able to accommodate extra adults.
