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Homework/Apps/Devices

Those of you who were recipients of ex-school iPads last year may now be experiencing some difficulties logging on to Mathletics and Spelling Shed. This is because both of these services have been updated and require a newer operating system than is held on your iPad.

- The Mathletics app now requires iOS 14.0 or newer to run and does not appear to run through the browser, Safari;
- Our Spelling Shed subscription was always meant to run through the browser Safari, not the app, but this is also failing to connect at the moment.

Tests in school have found some success with downloading the 'Google Chrome' app and running both of the above through that browser. It may be that your iOS does not support Chrome either but if you do manage to install it successfully, we believe it will work. I'm sorry that as updates are made, hardware inevitably gets left behind. If you do not have a device that will access homework, such as a mobile phone, home computer, etc - please let school know so that we can help your child to access their work in another way. Unfortunately, that does not include offering alternative devices for home as we no longer have any viable spare devices to share with you.
