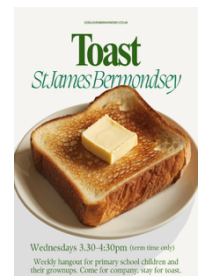
### **Shout Out Youth Theatre and Sports Camp**
