Families can listen to a show that explains about cancer cells, using puppets, animations and models.

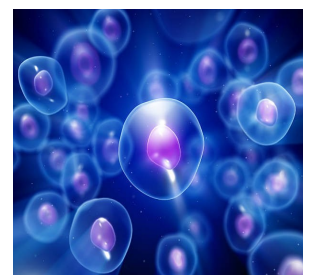
